

IT'S NOT TOO LATE! APPLY FOR UNIVERSITY NOW.

If the January deadline has passed,
it's not too late to apply for university.

GOOD NEWS!

Even after the main UCAS deadline, many universities will
still have some places available on their courses.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

You now have until **30th June*** to apply for a place at university.

Universities will consider applications on a first come first serve
basis, so the earlier you submit, the more likely you will find
a place on your chosen course and university.

* Oxbridge, Medicine, Veterinary and Dentistry,
are not open for late submissions.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO.

SEARCH FOR COURSES

- UCAS should have an up-to-date list of courses that still have places available. If you're not sure, email the university's admissions team directly to check the course is still open.



CREATE A UCAS ACCOUNT

- If you're applying through your school/college, find out your institutions buzzword to link your account.
- Use our **handy guide** to help you write your personal statement.
- Speak to a teacher about writing a reference for you.
- Submit your application.



APPLY FOR STUDENT FINANCE

- As soon as you've decided to go to university you should apply for Student Finance.
- Remember you don't need to have decided on your university to apply – this can all be changed at a later date.

APPLY FOR ACCOMMODATION

- Keep an eye out for emails from your university about applying for accommodation. There is usually a deadline you need to meet to guarantee your room.
- Remember to check your spam folder!



AFTER 30TH JUNE?

You can apply to university via **Clearing**.
Universities will advertise their clearing places on their website,
you will need to get in touch with the university directly via their
dedicated clearing channels.

* If you haven't already written a personal statement, you can still apply at this stage.
However universities will expect to see your personal statement before you start your course.
