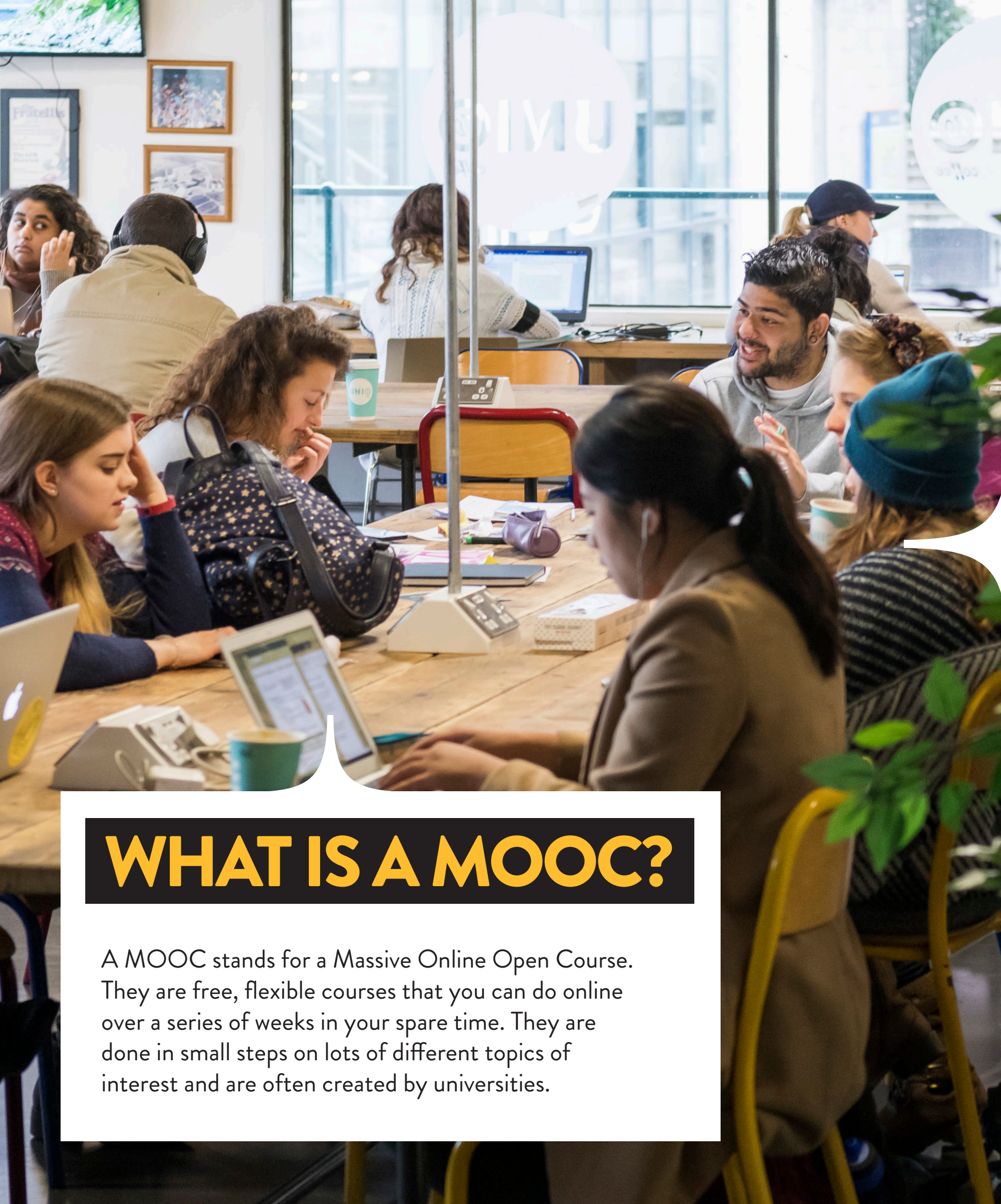

HOW DO I CHOOSE A MOOC?



The place to go for MOOCs is the FutureLearn website which has 100s of courses and gets updated constantly. That is a lot of choice! To narrow it down use the A-Z degree guide on the main document to find MOOCs related to your topic of interest.

You can also type in the institution you want to go to and see if there is a course by them about the subject you are interested in. Putting that on your personal statement is sure to be impressive.

WHAT IS A MOOC?

A MOOC stands for a Massive Online Open Course. They are free, flexible courses that you can do online over a series of weeks in your spare time. They are done in small steps on lots of different topics of interest and are often created by universities.
