30-45 mins

This session covers the benefits of higher education, including the impact a degree can have on career prospects as well as the social and life skills gained by studying at university.

Making the most of sixth form or college

20-30 mins

We'll discuss extra and supercurricular activities students can undertake while studying at sixth form or college to build skills and inform their next steps, as well as subject-specific tips for university applications.

Applying to university: the UCAS journey

30-45 mins

Students learn the ins and outs of the UCAS system. We discuss the basics, like how to apply, key dates and the steps they will need to undertake to reach their first few weeks of being a successful university student.

Writing a successful personal statement

30-45 mins

This in-depth session will give helpful advice and content with the aim of preparing students to make an educated start on their personal statements. Expect real examples and guidance on what admissions officers are looking for.

Making the most of HE fairs, open days and summer holidays

20-30 mins

This talk will support your students in exploring opportunities after sixth form or college. We'll talk about researching universities, how to make the most of HE and UCAS events, and what to do in the summer holidays.

Which higher education course is right for me?

30-45 mins

This talk provides guidance on how to narrow down choices to find the right course and university for your students. We will weigh up the options, suggest questions to ask during the research process and then demonstrate the benefits of spending time researching and visiting universities.

Why UEA?

20-30 mins

Learn everything you need to know about our internationally renowned university. In this session, we'll explore our undergraduate courses, social and sport activities and what it's like to live and study in Norwich.

Study abroad and placement opportunities

20-30 mins

University degrees have lots to offer beyond the standard three-year course. In this session, we'll discuss what it's like to study abroad or take a work placement year, where students could go, the benefits of both and the support that's available.


