THE CASTLE

Norwich Castle is a striking Norman keep packed with history, art, and curious exhibitions, ideal for a quick cultural fix. Just a short walk away, explore the Royal Arcade's stunning Art Nouveau architecture and indie shops, or unwind in the hidden charm of the Plantation Garden. A perfect blend of heritage and calm, right in the heart of the city.



THE MARKET

Norwich Market is one of the oldest and largest open-air markets in the UK, bursting with colour, character, and over 190 stalls offering everything from global street food to vintage gems. Just steps away, you'll find The Forum's buzzing public space and exhibitions, or catch a show at the Theatre Royal.



EARLHAM AND UNTHANK ROAD

Known as the Golden Triangle, this area is a very popular location for many UEA students to live once they move out of campus accommodation, usually after their first year. There are a useful selection of shops and restaurants in this area and it is easy to cycle to UEA as well as being on the main bus routes both to UEA and Norwich city centre.



SHOPPING


Chantry Place and Castle Quarter are home to an exciting choice of high street shops. A variety of independent stores are also located in surrounding areas and offer a range of goods to suit all tastes. Be sure to explore our cobbled streets to see what you can discover. In addition. a number of retail parks are situated within easy walking distance of the city centre.



THE LANES

The Norwich Lanes are a maze of cobbled streets full of indie charm and hidden gems. Grab award-winning fish and chips at Grosvenor Fish Bar, flip through vinyl at Soundclash Records, or browse Elm's unique range.

Alternatively, check out Bowling House, or head to Gonzo's Tea Room for rooftop vibes and towering burgers. Perfect for students on a budget keen to explore the city's creative side.





TOMBLAND

Tombland is a historic pocket of Norwich where medieval charm meets modern eats. Feast on fresh Japanese dishes at Shiki, enjoy Thai flavours at Giggling Squid, or grab a cosy Italian at Zizzi, all nestled among cobbled streets and cathedral views.



Home to an Odeon cinema, bowling, trampolining, a gym, and a wide range of restaurants, the area offers something for everyone. Nearby, you'll find Carrow Road, a leisure centre, retail park, and The Waterfront music venue across the River Wensum.



Carrow Road is home to Norwich City football club and host to many concerts including Arctic Monkeys, Elton John and more. Nearby, Whitlingham Adventure offers a variety of water and land based activities, whilst the Norfolk Snowsports Club is one of the UK's leading dry ski establishments.
