Global Cyber security update – There has been a recent wide-spread cyber-attack which affected many organisations, including some NHS trust sites. UEA has not been significantly impacted by this threat and to date only one instance of that specific outbreak has been recorded. UEA had itself been a victim circa 10 years ago when there was an attack on the climatic research centre and since, significant investment

has taken place to protect the UEA IT infrastructure and continues. We are looking to become accredited with cyber-essentials, which is a requirement when obtaining some Government funded research grant. It is included on the risk map as presented to Audit Committee.
