SENIOR LEADER APPRENTICESHIP

Our Senior Leader Apprenticeship (SLA) is designed for senior managers and future leaders from a diverse range of industries. Our flexible course delivery enables you to balance your study with work and family commitments.

Designed by employers in conjunction with the Chartered Management Institute (CMI), the Senior Leader Apprenticeship focuses on work-based learning. blended with business education that will benefit any organisation.

If you work for a UK company with a pay bill over £3 million, your employer may be able to use their Apprenticeship Levy to fund the SLA.

The SLA enables you to apply academic theory directly to real business challenges - meaning an immediate impact for your organisation.

The programme is mapped to our Executive MBA course.

As part of the SLA, you will complete six 20-credit modules - this will fulfil the requirements of the apprenticeship and allow you to gain a Postgraduate Diploma in Strategic Leadership. You will also be eligible Chartered Manager Status from the CMI.

You will be taught alongside our Executive MBA students, with lectures and seminars delivered over some full weekdays and at weekends, together with online afternoon/ evening teaching.

Flexible learning



TOP-UP TO MBA

The top-up course includes two 10-credit optional modules and a 40-credit Management Consultancy module which incorporates an international consultancy project.

The cohort I have joined includes a real mix of private and public sector talent. I am able to share my business challenges with people who come from different organisation


with different expertise to me and collectively we support one another as our careers unfold.
