I am writing with regard to the resignation of Phillip Campbell, which was announced on Channel Four news today. I think this was the correct decision in the circumstances.

I would like to suggest a way for you to recruit a suitable replacement, since you will undoubtedly still require the services of someone with expertise in the ethics of publication in scientific journals. For your information, I have recently submitted a paper to COPE on the UEA emails so that their board can consider what lessons can be learned from the affair.

In addition, I would suggest that Professor Boulton's background in the University of East Anglia and his statements on global warming leave the panel with an unbalanced appearance and you may wish to consider if this is appropriate or if it can be offset by the appointment of someone of the opposite persuasion.
