Whether you'd like an accredited module learning with other students from around the world, a subject specific course to enhance your learning, or are studying at UEA as part of a group from your home university, we bring all summer study students together for the best summer experience. Check out the following options for summer study at UEA.

Pathways to Sustainability: a multi-disciplinary approach

We're all interested in sustainability, aren't we? Aligned to the United Nations' (UN) Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), sdgs.un.org/goals, this programme offers you the opportunity to learn from academics, local businesses, and peers as you draw from your own and others' experiences of how global matters are addressed by our nations.

Alongside a multi-disciplinary approach to sustainability, you will work in groups on a sustainable business project, culminating in a formative assessment presentation. You will develop many graduate employability skills – team working, communication, intercultural communication, presentation skills and cultural awareness.

This programme can be taken as a 2- or 4-week accredited option for 10 or 20 UK University Credits. UEA's extended project option is available to provide an additional 5 UK University Credits.

This summer programme is open for students from our partner universities, through agencies and by individual application. Students from our partner universities may be eligible for preferential rates, so always chat with your home university before you apply.

Customised programmes

We deliver bespoke residential programmes throughout the year, usually in June, July and August, created to meet the needs of our partner universities. Together we design content to develop academic knowledge and employability skills, including enhancing students' understanding of British culture.

Students will gain in-depth subject knowledge through taught classes and project work, gaining academic connections, experiential learning and utilising teaching facilities.

Work Integrated Learning

UEA's Work Integrated Learning (W-I-L) programme is offered for groups from our partner universities. Students undertake

an intensive two-week course, providing professional business consultancy to a local business in our region, working in groups on a client brief, alongside facilitated teaching from UEA academics throughout the programme.

Our experienced team will support your customised programme every step of the way, from discussing the initial concept, to coordinating academic sessions from

a range of subject areas, as well as organising an exciting cultural programme to complement the experience. We warmly invite our partner universities to collaborate on teaching.

PAY THE PROGRAMME FEE AND APPLY FOR A VISA

If applicable, depending on visa regulations applying to your home country, you may be required to obtain a short-term visa to enter the UK. We can help you by providing an invitation letter to support your application.

YOU ARRIVE ON CAMPUS

You will join welcome events together with other summer study students. Activities include a welcome meal, campus tours and ice breakers to help you feel at home and make new friends before the programme starts.

5

YOU START YOUR SUMMER PROGRAMME

After induction and orientation, you will start your chosen summer study programme and enjoy your experience at UEA.
