### **Statutory Prevent Duty**

Dear Colleagues,

The Counter-Terrorism and Security Act 2015 places a statutory duty ('Prevent') upon all of us at the University to play our part in ensuring our students, our apprentices and staff are not drawn into radical or extremist groups, ideologies, or causes which could lead them into terrorism. We report annually to the Office for Students (OfS) on our compliance on this.

The University recognises that within its diverse community there may be members and visitors who are vulnerable at any given time. UEA is committed in its obligation to protect children and adults who are at risk of harm, abuse, neglect, discrimination or exploitation. Preventing a student or apprentice from being drawn into terrorism or supporting terrorism is fundamentally a safeguarding duty.

We all have a legal responsibility to be aware of safeguarding issues and what to do when faced with a potential concern. Any concern that a student or apprentice is being radicalised and exploited by others into supporting terrorism or criminal acts should be raised under UEA's Safeguarding Policy, which outlines our legal responsibility to protect all adults at risk of harm and children so that they are safe and secure in the University environment.

We continue to monitor and review relevant policies and how we implement them, including our <u>Safeguarding Policy</u>, our <u>Code of Practice on Freedom of Speech</u>, and our policies and facilities for providing support to our multi-faith community to ensure that these generic policies and the way in which we employ them align with our obligations under Prevent.

# Freedom of Speech

The government has confirmed that the Higher Education (Freedom of Speech) Act 2023 will come into force on 1 August 2025. Our Code of Practice on Freedom of Speech has been updated to reflect the requirements of the Act and we are of course staying close to what the developments mean for us as an institution. We will provide further updates over the summer and as our new students start in the autumn.

What hasn't changed is our institutional position on neutrality and the important responsibility we all share to create a culture of trust where we have regard for alternative perspectives and differences, and champion the free exchange of ideas. Through our <a href="People Strategy">People Strategy</a> we recognise the importance of good relations on campus and have set out our approach to increase understanding of the relationship between freedom of speech and protection from discrimination and harassment. We are all committed to ensuring that UEA is a community where we welcome free expression in a safe environment.

#### **External Speakers**

Please remember that you must let the University know the names of any external speaker invited to campus or invited to address staff, students or apprentices online or for an extra-curricular activity to ensure the safety of all concerned. This must notify us at least 10 days ahead of the planned event via this <a href="webform">webform</a>. If you have any questions, please contact the team via <a href="mailto:speakers@uea.ac.uk">speakers@uea.ac.uk</a>.

### Safeguarding training

All staff must complete the <u>Safeguarding training course on LearnUpon</u>, with refresher training due every 3 years. This course explains your responsibilities as a member of UEA staff, helps you to identify safeguarding and Prevent concerns, and explains what to do when faced with a concern, a disclosure or an allegation.

#### Research and scholarship issues

There will be some instances where colleagues, students or apprentices, wish to access terrorist material or material from proscribed organisations for genuine academic study. Staff and students must notify the University Secretary (via <a href="University.Secretary@uea.ac.uk">University.Secretary@uea.ac.uk</a>) or their Head of School/Faculty PVC of any plans to access such material as part of any form of academic endeavour, so that appropriate advice and support can be given and best practice followed.

#### Report and Support

The dedicated Report and Support website enables students, apprentices, and staff to report any incident of bullying, hate crime and discrimination, harassment, and sexual harassment. This can be done anonymously or if someone would like to receive support from a trained adviser, and/or importantly they would like to have a discussion about how they would like the University to act on the information, they can leave their contact details. The site also lists sources of internal and external support. All Report and Support resources and report form can be found online.

#### **Employee Assistance Programme**

All staff have access to support via the Employee Assistance Programme, which provides 24/7 access to a wide range of support on any personal or professional issues that may be affecting home or professional life, studies, health or general wellbeing. There is also a 24/7 confidential telephone helpline, 0800 030 5182, where experienced advisers are available. More information can be found on MyUEA.







and I discussed the event with a meeting which eloquently summarised as below;

Just to update you that SU/Student plans to screen the film 'To kill a war machine' have been put on hold following advice given to SU staff member by Palestine Action. The plan by UK Government to proscribe the group under terror laws is happening today, with house of lords debate tomorrow and an expected implementation at the weekend, however the group are seeking high court approval of a challenge to the governments actions. Given all this the group have apparently advised to hold off arranging screenings until there is greater clarity as to the groups status.

We have agreed to revisit to potential of screening the film again next week once the groups position is better understood, myself and Ann will keep you up to date as and when we know more.





#### Dear all

We have received some intelligence that there is a possibility of protest in support of Palestine during the graduation ceremonies next week. This has happened in the past and is most likely to take the form of graduating students wearing the colours of the Palestinian flag either in a scarf or badge. Some may abstain from shaking the presiding officer's hand. There will always be security officers in the hall and in the event of anything more serious e.g. someone sitting down on the stage the team will, if they don't move quickly, bring in some privacy screens and then arrange to move them on. In the event of any chanting or potential breaches in respect of Palestine Action the team will use their body worn cameras to gather evidence and report after the event through the normal Prevent channels. We know there were protests at Cambridge graduation events.

We will receive further updates if there are any confirmed cases but at this stage hope that any protests will take the normal format of being peaceful and respectful.

The University do not record security expenditure separately for events on campus, unless additional resources or security personnel are procured specifically to cover such an event. There were no additional expenditures incurred any additional security during pro-Palestine protests or encampments during the requested period.
