Where do you come from and how far is it from UEA?

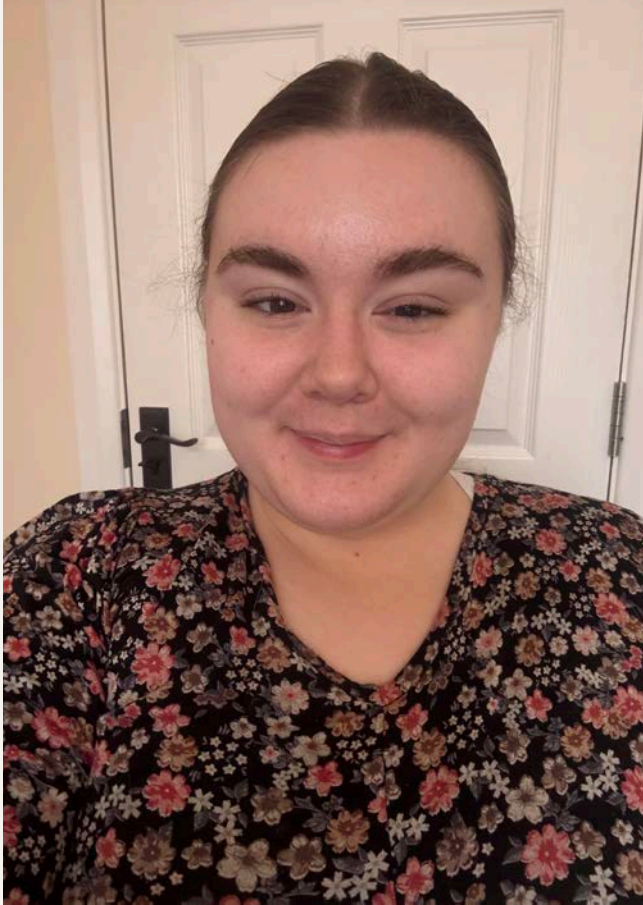

What's your social life like here in Norwich? Where do you typically hang out?

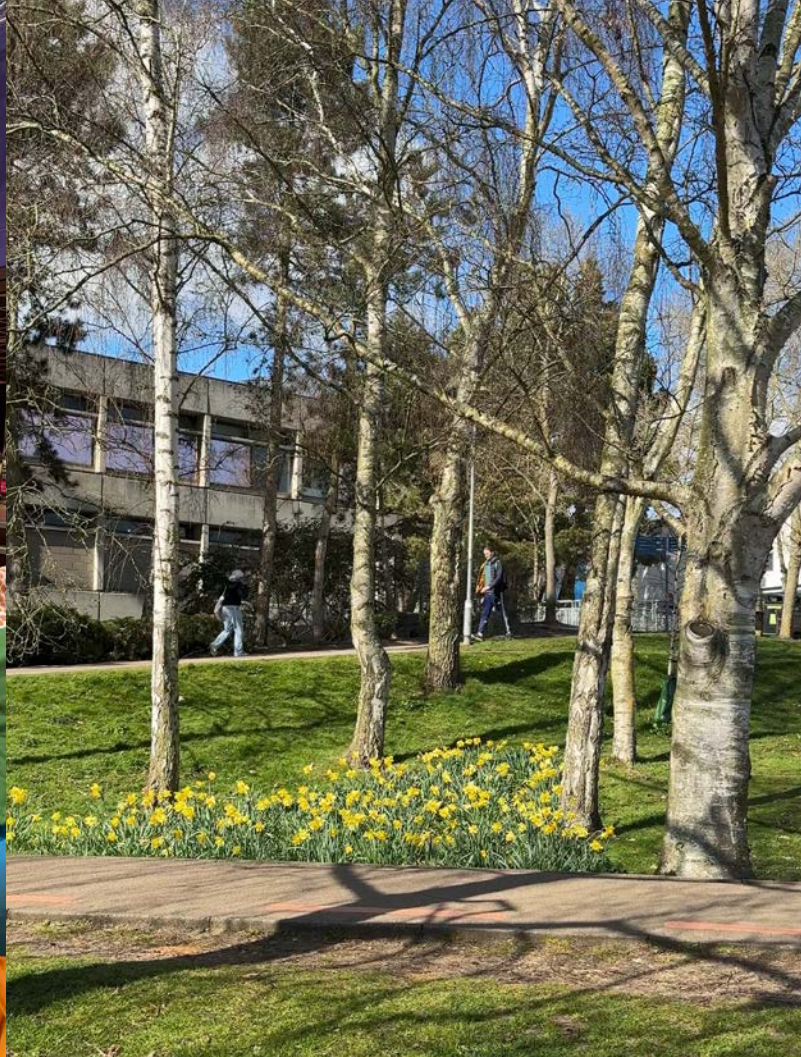
I have quite a nice group of friends, and my favourite place to hang out is with a picnic by the lake (in warm weather) or catching up in a coffee shop.

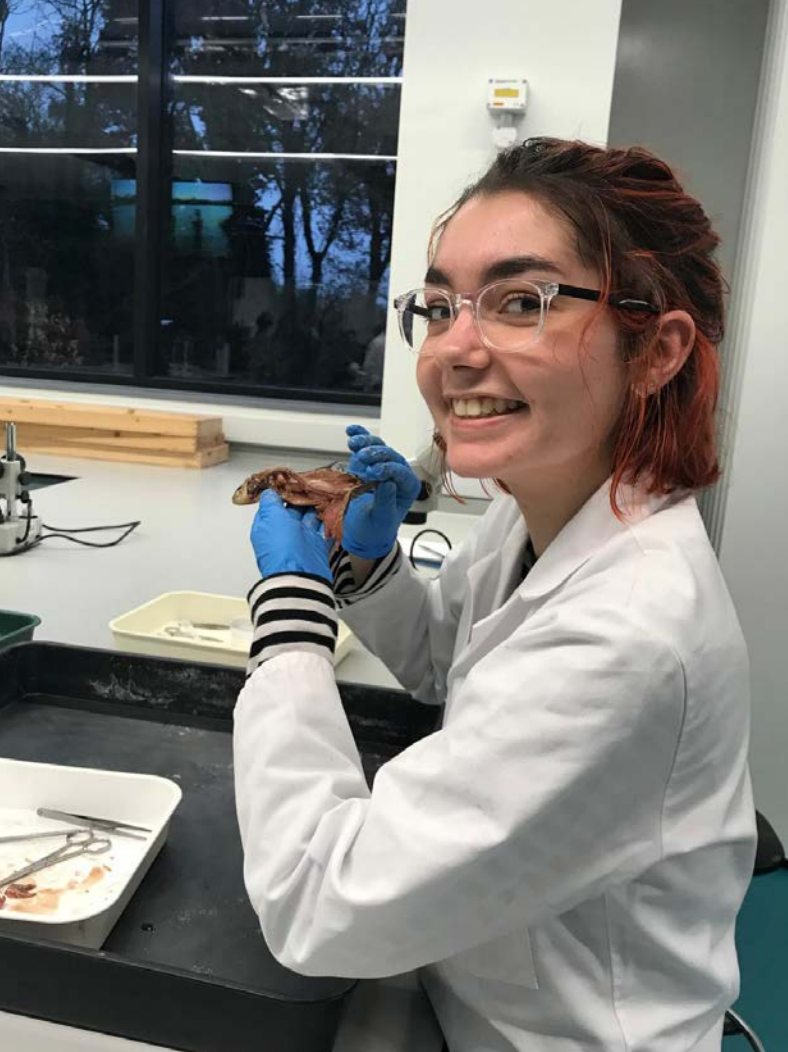
